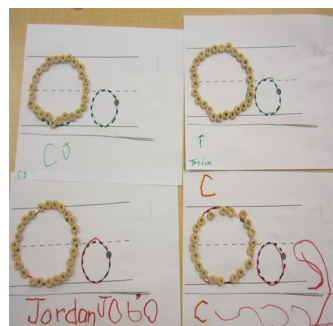

*We DO have school on Veteran's Day.*



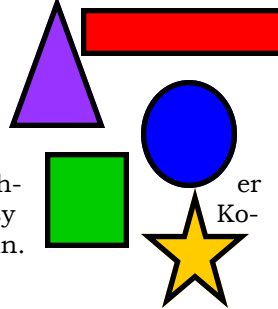
## WQED PEG + CAT MATH IQ
