

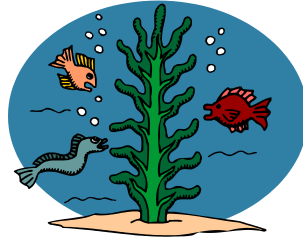

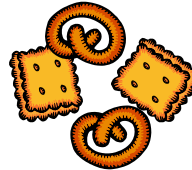

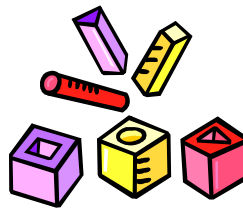

On January 13th The Early Intervention Program PPS will be giving FREE developmental screenings. This free screening will check for speech, large and fine motor skills and cognitive skills. This screening is a good

way to check for developmental delays or problems . They will play a few "games" with your child, each screening is about 10 minutes long.
